

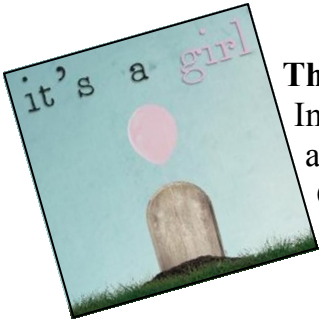


BCS Diversity Committee Presents... *Our 2015-16 Film Series*

ordinary new journey in their transformation to men.

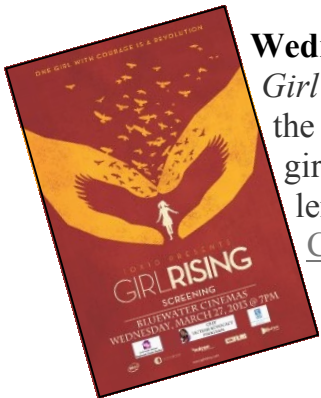
