Application Procedure

- The Snow Club will accept 56 skiers/snowboarders; these spots will be filled on a first-come-first-served basis.
 - We will pass out application packets after the **Parent Information meeting on Tuesday, November 15th, 6:30 pm.**
 - Applications will also be available in the main office starting Nov. 16th or BCS website.
 - We will begin to **accept applications on Wednesday, December 7th at 8:00 a.m.** at the table located outside the main office. Each application will be date/time-stamped.
 - When all 56 spots are filled we will waitlist applications in order of receipt of application. We will notify any additional applicants by email/phone as soon as possible if more room is available on the bus.

Your application submission should include the following:

- BCS Proud Dads Snow Club Application/Permission form
 - Check made payable to: BCS in the amount of \$255
 - Birmingham Public Schools Physical Evaluation form, signed/dated after April 15th, 2016 (if not already submitted for another sport-only one Physical Evaluation form is needed per school year)
 - Pine Knob Ski Area Rental Agreement, if applicable

Snow Club Dates: (Bus leaves BCS at 3:30 pm and returns approx. 8:20 pm)

We ski at Pine Knob on eight (8) Tuesdays:

- December 20th
 - January 3rd, 10th, 17th, 24th and 31st
 - February 7th and 14th Feb 28th will be used as a make-up date, if needed.

Costs:

- \$255 – covers transportation, skier card or snowboarding card, and lift tickets
- Club fee is non-refundable/non-transferrable and lift tickets must be used during assigned BCS Snow club sessions
- Information on additional lessons for skiing/snowboarding will be provided by Pine Knob representative
- Rentals are not included in the club cost: \$20 for ski rental/snowboard each trip, \$10 for helmet each trip
- Patches are \$2.50 (required past the bunny hill)
- Food: Students are responsible to pay for their own dinner/snacks/drinks
